Re: Comments on Advisory Opinion Request 2006-11

Dear Mr. Norton:

We are writing on behalf of the Washington Democratic State Central Committee (the "Committee") to express our support for the draft Advisory Opinion 2006-11 circulated by the Office of General Counsel on April 13, 2006 (the "Draft AO"). We also seek additional clarification regarding the sentence: "No contribution or coordinated expenditure would be made by the State Party Committee so long as the PCC pays at least its proportionate share of the cost of the mass mailing." Draft AO at 6, line 8. Specifically, we wish to confirm that it is permissible for the portion of a mailing attributable to a clearly identified candidate in the Draft AO to be one or a combination of the following: (1) an in-kind contribution, subject to the limitations, restrictions and requirements of 11 C.F.R. §§ 109.32 and 109.33, or (3) reimbursed by the clearly identified federal candidate or his or her authorized committee. See 11 C.F.R. § 106.8(b)(2).
