Please supplement the above complaint with the following recent development.

After the November 24, 2003 debate referenced in my letter of November 20, 2003, Senator Joseph Lieberman was interviewed by Chris Matthews on MSNBC. Senator Lieberman, like Senators Edwards and Kerry, did not travel to Iowa, but remained in Washington for a congressional vote.

Edwards and Kerry were included in the debate via satellite hookup from outside the Senate chambers. Lieberman told Matthews that he had originally planned to bypass the Iowa debate as he is not running in the Iowa caucus, but when he learned of the special arrangements made for Edwards and Kerry, he sought to be included. However, he received a call from Terry McAuliffe, Chairperson of the Democratic National Committee, stating, apparently without explanation, that he was not going to be included.

This incident supports complainants' contention that participation in the debates is being determined by the Democratic Party, not by the staging organizations on the basis of preestablished objective criteria.
