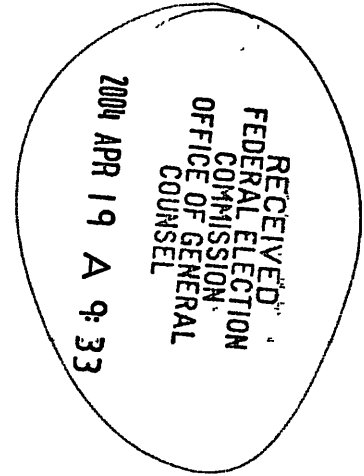

Dear Mr. Jordan:

As you know, I represent complainants in the above MUR and write in furtherance of our telephone conversation of April 2, 2004.

This is a presidential election year, and my clients believe it is imperative that the Commission act aggressively and expeditiously to insure that its regulations governing debates are not flaunted or subverted. The Commission's failure to actively investigate and otherwise act in a timely manner on the serious allegations made in the above MUR would only encourage further non-compliance by debate sponsors to the detriment of the public interest in fair and non-partisan presidential debates in which candidates are included on the basis of pre-existing objective criteria.

On my clients' behalf I am advising that it is their intention to pursue the judicial remedies available to them if they are not satisfied that their complaint is being treated in a timely manner.
