The Federal Election Commission previously notified Dow Jones of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On January 19, 2005, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided in this matter, that there is no reason to believe Dow Jones violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b and 11 C.F.R. § 110.13. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
