The Federal Election Commission has considered the allegations contained in the complaint dated December 9, 2015, and its supplement dated January 13, 2016, that you filed on behalf of Right to Rise PAC, Inc. The Commission was equally divided on whether to dismiss the allegations. Accordingly, on July 13, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
