 - a. Find reason to believe that David Garrett violated 52 U.S.C. § 30124(b)(1) in his personal capacity.
 - b. Enter into conciliation with Americans for Sensible Solutions PAC and David Garrett in his official capacity as treasurer and his personal capacity prior to a finding of probable cause to believe.
 - c. Approve the conciliation agreement, as recommended in the Second General Counsel's Report dated June 17, 2020.
 - d. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis for David Garrett, as recommended in the Second General Counsel's Report dated June 17, 2020.
 - e. Approve the appropriate letter.

Dismiss on the grounds of *Heckler v. Chaney*.
