On October 14, 2016, your clients, Make America Number 1 and Jacquelyn James in her official capacity as treasurer, were notified that the Federal Election Commission received a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. At that time, your clients were given a copy of the complaint and informed that a response to the complaint should be submitted within 15 days of receipt of the notification. This office is also in receipt of a request from you asking for an extension to respond to the original complaint. The request for an extension is granted.

Further, on December 2, 2016, the Commission received additional information from the complainant pertaining to the allegations in the complaint. Enclosed is a copy of this additional information. If you wish to consider this additional information in your response to the allegations, you are hereby afforded additional time to do so. Accordingly, your response is due on or before close of business day December 30, 2016.
