On October 14, 2016, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified your client, Make America Number 1 and Jacquelyn James in her official capacity as treasurer, that it received a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). On January 11, 2022, the Commission considered the complaint and closed its file in this matter.
