On October 14, 2016, the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) notified your clients, Donald J. Trump for President, Inc. and Bradley T. Crate in his official capacity as treasurer, that it received a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (“the Act”). On January 11, 2022, the Commission considered the complaint and closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission’s decision will follow.
