

**FIFTH CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME  
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission’s (“Commission’s”) decision to grant the request of Respondent GEO Corrections Holdings, Inc., for a probable cause hearing pursuant to the Commission’s policy set forth at 72 Fed. Reg. 64919 (Nov. 19, 2007), in connection with the above-referenced matter, Respondent, by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations, found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter, for any civil enforcement action that the Commission might institute against Respondent in connection with MUR 7180, pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6). The period of tolling shall equal the number of days from July 29, 2020 (the date of Respondent’s probable cause hearing request) through the date of the probable cause hearing.

This consent supplements Consents previously agreed to by GEO Corrections Holdings, Inc. on May 31, 2018; June 13, 2018; September 15, 2019; and May 20, 2020, with the periods agreed to in each Consent running consecutively.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
