Dear Ms. Dennis:

It has become inescapably obvious through the announcement of one Mr. M.Zuckerberg that at the very minimum \$100,000 has been allocated and spent illegally for the election campaign of Mr. Trump. In addition, public statements alleged by Ms. Rachael Maddow tie, Mr. Jared Kushner, with the co-ordination of the dissemination of digital data provided by President Putin. Due to the undisclosed nature of Mr. Putin's action, it is difficult to determine the extent, breadth, and more importantly for this action, his costs to support this treachery. Given the complexity of the logistical requirements to mount this campaign, it would most probably have taken at least 2 to 5 years, although President has has extensive personal dealings with Russian business community and therefor by extension, the Russian government since 1990's.

Fortunately, the Russians are highly reliable record keepers, and I believe they could provide you with the sums spent on this project within the range of R1,000, to R10,000.
