On March 5, 2020, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that an unknown respondent had violated the Federal Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, by failing to report independent expenditures and failing to include disclaimers on paid Facebook advertisements. You were also notified at that time that an investigation by the Office of the General Counsel uncovered information suggesting that you might be the unknown respondent. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on April 28, 2022, to take no further action and close the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
