| 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36 37 38 | On May 16, 2023, the Office of General Counsel ("OGC") notified Ryan Phillips ("Respondent") that it was prepared to recommend that the Commission find probable cause to believe that Respondent knowingly and willfully violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30114(b) and 30102(b)(3) by converting \$46,226.66 in committee funds from Heller for Senate to personal use and by commingling \$12,204.68 of funds from HellerHighWater PAC with his own, through unauthorized withdrawals, checks, and electronic transfers. ¹ OGC's notification included a General Counsel's Brief setting forth the factual and legal basis for the recommendation. Respondent did not submit a response to the Probable Cause Brief. No new information has been presented in this matter that would affect the conclusions of the General Counsel's Brief.
