On June 5, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified In Compliance, Inc. (“Respondent”) of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). On June 6, 2024, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by Respondent and other information, the Commission determined to dismiss the allegations that In Compliance, Inc. violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30114(b) and 30102(b)(3). Accordingly, the Commission voted to close its file in this matter effective July 8, 2024.
