Dear Mr. Crosland:

On December 22, 2016, May 10, 2017, August 15, 2017, and July 25, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Donald J. Trump, Make America Great Again PAC (formerly known as Donald J. Trump for President, Inc.), and Bradley T. Crate in his official capacity as treasurer, of multiple complaints alleging that your clients had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On April 22, 2021, the Commission considered the complaints but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe your clients violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.20(g), or that Make America Great Again PAC (formerly known as Donald J. Trump for President, Inc.), and Bradley T. Crate in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(3). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter as it pertains to your clients. A Statement of Reasons providing the basis for the Commission's decision will be forthcoming when the entire file in these matters closes. These matters will become part of the public record within 30 days after the entire file is closed with respect to all other respondents involved.

You are advised that the confidentiality provisions of 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(12)(A) remain in effect, and that these matters are still open with respect to other respondents.
