Dear Ms. Ros-Lehtinen:

On October 28, 2019, the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) notified you of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to you at that time.

The Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe, and equally divided on whether to find no reason to believe, you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b), a provision of the Act. Accordingly, on February 17, 2022, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission’s decision will follow.
