 - c. Enter into conciliation with James R. Schwartz II prior to a finding of probable cause to believe.
 - d. Approve the Conciliation Agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated November 8, 2022,
 - e. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated November 8, 2022.
 - f. Approve the appropriate letter.
