SECOND CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission's agreement to extend the period of time for pre-probable cause to believe conciliation negotiations in this matter, Respondent, James R. Schwartz II, hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement suit that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7677 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in these matters.
