

 - b. Dismiss the allegations that Eugene DePasquale for Pennsylvania and DePasquale for PA 10 and Rick Galena in his official capacity as treasurer violated 11 C.F.R. § 110.3(d) by transferring assets to the DePasquale for PA 10 and Rick Galena in his official capacity as treasurer in connection with its testing-the-waters activities.
