AMENDED CERTIFICATION

I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on May 31, 2023, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
 - a. Find reason to believe that Marjorie Taylor Greene violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e)(1)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 300.61 by soliciting non-federal funds.
 - b. Take no action at this time as to Stop Socialism Now PAC and Jason D. Boles in his official capacity as treasurer.
 - c. Enter into conciliation with Marjorie Taylor Greene prior to a finding of probable cause to believe.
 - d. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 13, 2023.
 - e. Approve the Conciliation Agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 13, 2023.
 - f. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Lindenbaum, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.

2. Decided by a vote of 5-0 to:
- a. Find reason to believe that Marjorie Taylor Greene violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e)(1)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 300.61 by soliciting non-federal funds.
 - b. Take no action at this time as to Stop Socialism Now PAC and Jason D. Boles in his official capacity as treasurer.
 - c. Enter into conciliation with Marjorie Taylor Greene prior to a finding of probable cause to believe.
 - d. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated February 13, 2023, subject to the edits last circulated by Vice Chairman Cooksey's Office on Thursday, May 25, 2023 at 11:40 a.m.
 - e. Direct the Office of General Counsel to redraft a Conciliation Agreement,
 - f. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision. Commissioner Trainor abstained.
