15 16 17 18 19 20	On May 31, 2023, the Commission voted, <i>inter alia</i> , to (1) find reason to believe that Marjorie Taylor Greene violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e)(1)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 300.61 by soliciting non-federal funds; (2) enter into conciliation with Marjorie Taylor Greene prior to a finding of probable cause to believe; (3) approve a Factual and Legal Analysis subject to edits circulated by Vice Chairman Cooksey's Office; and (4) direct the Office of General Counsel to redraft a Conciliation Agreement, consistent with the edits to the Factual and Legal Analysis. <sup>1</sup>
