Recommendation to Approve Revised Conciliation Agreement

15 On May 31, 2023, the Commission voted, *inter alia*, to (1) find reason to believe that  
16 Marjorie Taylor Greene violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e)(1)(A) and 11 C.F.R. § 300.61 by  
17 soliciting non-federal funds; (2) enter into conciliation with Marjorie Taylor Greene prior to a  
18 finding of probable cause to believe; (3) approve a Factual and Legal Analysis subject to edits  
19 circulated by Vice Chairman Cooksey's Office; and (4) direct the Office of General Counsel to  
20 redraft a Conciliation Agreement, consistent with the edits to the Factual and Legal Analysis.<sup>1</sup>
