Dear Ms. Baranowicz:

As you know, I represent Renacci for US Senate in connection with MUR 7928. I am writing to request the Commission delay any further action with respect to MUR 7928 until the resolution of *Federal Election Commission v. Ted Cruz for Senate* (No. 21-12) currently before the Supreme Court. This case is challenging the constitutionality of the loan repayment limit when a candidate's personal loans to the candidate's campaign committee exceed \$250,000. The use of Commission resources to pursue an outcome at this time would be premature, as a decision in this case may result in changes to the reporting requirements of loans made by the candidate to his committee and the repayment of those loans, which are at issue here, or result in such issues being mooted.
