## THIRD CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO COMMENCE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION, SUIT, OR PROCEEDING

Renacci for US Senate and Russell Corwin in his official capacity as treasurer ("Respondent") hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action, suit, or proceeding that the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") might institute in connection with matter under review ("MUR") 7928, pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6), until thirty (30) calendar days after the Supreme Court of the United States issues a final decision in Federal Election Commission v. Ted Cruz for Senate, et al. (No. 21-12).

This agreement extends the five-year statute of limitations at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, and any other statute of limitations or reposes that may be applicable in this matter. This agreement supplements the Consent to Extend the Time to Commence a Civil Law Enforcement Action, Suit, or Proceeding dated October 1, 2021, and the Second Consent to Extend the Time to Commence a Civil Law Enforcement Action, Suit, or Proceeding dated October 29, 2021. There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to commence a civil law enforcement action, suit, or proceeding without the written consent of Respondent.
