I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary for the Federal Election Commission executive session on June 21, 2023, do hereby certify that the Commission decided by a vote of 4-1 to take the following actions in MUR 7957:

1. Find no reason to believe that Marie Newman for Congress and Holly Giarraputo in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) by converting campaign funds to personal use.
2. Find no reason to believe that Marie Newman violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) by converting campaign funds to personal use.
3. Find no reason to believe that Iymen Chehade violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) by converting campaign funds to personal use.
4. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion allegations that Marie Newman for Congress and Holly Giarraputo in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(5)(A) by reporting improper disbursements purposes.
5. Close the file.
6. Issue appropriate letters.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the decision. Commissioner Broussard dissented. Commissioner Weintraub abstained.
