On June 2, 2022, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a Complaint indicating violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the Complaint was forwarded to you at that time.

The Commission considered the Complaint, and on June 21, 2023, found no reason to believe that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) by converting campaign funds to personal use.
