CERTIFICATION

I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on June 22, 2023, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 2-4 to:
  - a. Find reason to believe that White Coat Waste PAC and Janna Rutland in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30103(b)(2) by failing to include the name, address, relationship, and type of its connected organization in its statement of organization.
  - b. Find reason to believe that White Coat Waste PAC and Janna Rutland in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(e)(5) and 11 C.F.R. § 102.14(c) by failing to include in its name the full name of its connected organization, White Coat Waste Project, Inc.
  - c. Find reason to believe that White Coat Waste PAC and Janna Rutland in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(b)(4)(A)(i) and 11 C.F.R. § 114.5(g)(1) by soliciting contributions from persons of outside of its connected organization's restricted class.
  - d. Take no action at this time as to White Coat Waste Project, Inc., Anthony Bellotti, and Justin Goodman.
  - e. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated May 4, 2023.
  - f. Approve compulsory process.
  - g. Approve appropriate letter.

Commissioners Broussard and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, and Trainor dissented.

2. Decided by a vote of 4-2 to:

- a. Find no reason to believe that White Coat Waste PAC and Janna Rutland in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30103(b)(2) by failing to include the name, address, relationship, and type of its connected organization in its statement of organization.
- b. Find no reason to believe that White Coat Waste PAC and Janna Rutland in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30102(e)(5) and 11 C.F.R. § 102.14(c) by failing to include in its name the full name of its connected organization, White Coat Waste Project, Inc.
- c. Find no reason to believe that White Coat Waste PAC and Janna Rutland in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118(b)(4)(A)(i) and 11 C.F.R. § 114.5(g)(1) by soliciting contributions from persons of outside of its connected organization's restricted class.
- d. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion allegations that White Coat Waste Project, Inc. made and White Coat Waste PAC and Janna Ruthland in her official capacity as treasurer accepted prohibited in-kind corporate contributions in violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a).
- e. Close the file.
- f. Issue appropriate letters.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the decision. Commissioners Broussard and Weintraub dissented.
