Dear Mr. Gessler:

On October 21, 2022, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, For Colorado's Future and Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer ("Committee"), of a complaint alleging that it had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your client at that time. Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by you, the Commission, on May 15, 2024, voted to dismiss the allegation that the Committee violated 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a)(2) and 11 C.F.R. § 115.2(c) by knowingly soliciting a federal contractor contribution.
