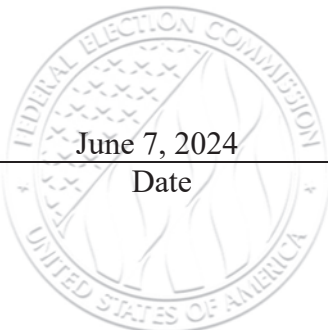
CERTIFICATION

I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary for the Federal Election Commission executive session on June 06, 2024, do hereby certify that the Commission decided by a vote of 6-0 to take the following actions in MUR 8090:

1. Dismiss the allegation that Donald J. Trump or Save America and Bradley T. Crate in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e)(1)(A).
2. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated May 2, 2024, subject to the edits circulated by Vice Chair Weintraub's Office on June 6, 2024 at 9:46 a.m.
3. Approve the appropriate letters.
