On January 23, 2024, the Commission found reason to believe that PA Lawyer Fund and Raymond G. Lahoud in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(g)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.4(c) by failing to timely file a 24-Hour Report for \$2.5 million of independent expenditures immediately prior to the 2022 election. The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee.² The First General Counsel's Report noted that the Committee no longer had any
