*The figures presented in this table show receipt totals of the national parties' new convention, headquarters and recount accounts. On December 16, 2014, President Obama signed into law the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2015 (H.R. 83). Provisions of that law enable national party committees to establish accounts to defray certain expenses incurred with respect to presidential nominating conventions (for the DNC and RNC); national party headquarters buildings; and election recounts and contests and other legal proceedings.
