CERTIFICATION

I, Shelley E. Garr, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission open meeting on January 30, 2014 do hereby certify that the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

Find that RPIA failed to keep monthly time-logs for the payroll consisting of payments allocated between federal and non-federal funds and 100% non-federal payments, subject to an amendment to include \$58,424 paid to contract workers.

Commissioners Ravel, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Goodman, Hunter, and Peterson dissented.

2. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

- a. Find that RPIA failed to keep monthly time-logs for the \$336,569 in payroll allocated between federal and non-federal funds, pursuant to the meeting discussion and as amended by the email from Vice Chair Ravel's Office dated January 30, 2014.
- b. Direct the Audit Division to include in the Proposed Final Audit Report an Additional Issues section addressing the remaining amount for 100% non-federal payments.

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Commissioners Goodman, Hunter, Petersen, Ravel, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision.

3. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

Find that RPIA failed to itemize debts and obligations totaling \$179,856.

Commissioners Goodman, Hunter, Petersen, Ravel, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision.
